2. M/s Synergy Waste Management (P)Ltd, an occupier or operator of the facility located at Mohammadpur, Barabanki is hereby granted an authorization for;

3. M/s Synergy Waste Management (P) Ltd, Lucknow is hereby authorized for handling of biomedical waste as per the capacity given below.

 - (iii) Installed treatment and disposal capacity --
 - Capacity of Incinerator--250 Kg/hour
 - Capacity to Autoclave-- 75 Kg/hour
 - Capacity of Shredder -- 50 Kg/hour
 - Capacity of ETP -- 1 KLD
 - (iv) Quantity of Biomedical waste handled, treated or disposal-- 1183.70 Kg/day
 - (v) Area or distance covered by CBMWTF
 - Lucknow--45 Km
 - Hardoi --75 Km
 - Barabanki-5 Km
 - Sitapur -85 Km

This authorization shall be enforce for a period of **Five years** from the date of issue, Subject to valid consent under Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Air ((Prevention and Control of Pollution)Act,1981. In case the CBWTF unable to have valid consent the authorization shall be automatically cancelled.
5. This authorization is subject to the conditions stated below and to such other conditions as may be specified in the rules for the time being in force under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

TERM AND CONDITIONS

1. The Authorization shall comply with provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act 1986 and the rules made there under.
2. The Authorization or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer, Authorized by the prescribed authority.
3. The Authorized person shall not rent, lend, transfer or otherwise transport the bio-Medical waste without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
4. It is duty of the Authorized person to take prior permission of the Board to close down the facility and such other terms and conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.
5. Any unauthorized change in personnel, equipment or working condition as mentioned in the application by the person authorized shall constitute a breach of his authorization.
6. Bio- Medical waste shall not be mixed with other waste.
7. Bio- Medical waste shall be segregated into containers/ bags at the point of generation in accordance with schedule I. Prior to its storage, transportation, treatment and disposal. The Containers shall be labeled according as per provisions.
8. No untreated bio medical waste shall be kept stored beyond a period of 48 hours for period from January to December.
9. You shall submit an annual report to the U.P. Pollution Control Board in form IV by 30th June every year in compliance of Rule-8 of B.M.W. Rule, 2016. And include information about the categories and quantities of Bio Medical waste during the preceding year.
10. You shall maintain record related to the collection, ,storage, Transportation, treatment and disposal and / or any form of handling of Bio Medical Waste in accordance with rule and guidelines, all records shall be subject to inspection and verification by the Board at any time.
11. It is within the power and functions of U.P. Pollution Control Board to modify/ revoke the terms and conditions of Authorization and issued under the Rule 7 (8) of the Bio-Medical waste Management Rules, 2016.
12. You are hereby directed to comply the stipulated above mentioned conditions and submit the compliance report and steps taken in this regard within a month so that capacity of the facility may be verified failing which the authorization may be revoked and necessary legal proceeding shall be initiated.
13. The Bio medical waste shall not be disposed in open place in the premises.
14. This authorization is subject to the order of Hon'ble High Court in Criminal revision no. 2671/2008 and Criminal revision no. 2572/2008.
15. Strict compliance of Rule 18 and all other provisions of BMW Rule, 2016 must be ensured.
